DAY
01

Arrive at Deer Lake Airport or Port aux Basques via Marine Atlantic ferry and welcome to scenic Western Newfoundland. Proceed to Deer Lake via the TCH and exit to the Viking Trail (Route 430). Overnight in Deer Lake or Gros Morne National Park. Take part in local evening experiences or relax in the awe of your beautiful surroundings and unlimited fresh ocean air!

DAY
02

Journey along the Viking Trail into magical mountains and ancient fjords of Gros Morne National Park. Head for the Tablelands where the earth's mantle is exposed and could have you believing your walking on Mars! Learn more about the science of the Tablelands and the park at the Discovery Centre at nearby historic Woody Point. Overnight in Birchy Bay-Woody Point to Daniel's Harbour region with your choice of evening entertainment in both areas.

DAY
03

Awaken to the sounds of the roaring ocean and scenic vistas as you continue to make more amazing memories along the Viking Trail. Today's awe-inspiring explorations will bring you to the Western Brook Pond Boat Tour and into the breathtaking inland fjords of Gros Morne. Onward on your trek north, with stops at The Arches Provincial Park and heritage sites in Cow Head and Daniel's Harbour, as you drive along scenic coastline dotted with unique fishing villages. Head to the famous Torrent River Salmon Interpretation Centre in Hawke's Bay and other adventures in nearby Port au Choix National Historic Site and Point Riche Lighthouse. Overnight in Hawkes Bay or Port au Choix. Relax with local cuisine, a beautiful view or a friendly chat with locals.



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**DAY
04**

Your road to amazing memories continues north to the Vikings today at L'Anse aux Meadows UNESCO World Heritage Site. Stops along the way include Flower's Cove Thrombolites and GNP Crafts where seal skin products are made on site. Once you arrive in L'Anse aux Meadows, immerse in the sagas of the Vikings voyage to North America and experience the life of Vikings first hand in the living site. Stroll across to Norstead Viking Village where the living Viking Port of Trade will have you wandering into a Viking Village known as one of the best experiences in the area. Linkum Zodiac Tours out of nearby Quirpon will take you out in search of our majestic icebergs as whales and pods of dolphin's swim nearby. Stay overnight at Quirpon Island, Raleigh or St. Anthony! Evening entertainment may include a hike along many scenic trails in the area or experience the Great Viking Feast!

**DAY
05**

Awaken today to take in the surroundings of the very tip of the Viking Trail. Visit Fishing Point to take in spectacular morning views or board the boat tour out of St. Anthony Harbour into Iceberg Alley. Visit Grenfell Historical Properties and take a walk to Tea House Hill where stories of Dr. Grenfell's Legacy leaving you with chills up your spine. Travel south and east to the French Shore Historical Sites, home of the 222-foot French tapestry, in Conche where history and local culture collide into a beautiful Newfoundland outport. Take in local adventures with Tuckamore Tours or Mayflower Adventures or continue on your own to scenic world class Northeast Way trails all around the region. Overnight in Main Brook or Roddickton-Bide Arm.

**DAY
06**

Today you will head west across the vast wilderness of the Great Northern Peninsula to Plum Point and Bird Cove. At Bird Cove you'll explore the 50 Centuries Interpretation Centre where 5000 years of history unfolds in this small but active Newfoundland community. Hike and picnic along one of many trails to archeology sites and scenic vistas out on Bird Cove's Dog Peninsula, home to rare plants, birds and ocean breezes. Visit trails in nearby St. Barbe, Gateway to Labrador, St. Genevieve and Plum Point! Overnight at Plum Point to St. Barbe region. Local "boil ups" and ocean side camp fires are also common evening activities around these parts.

**DAY
07**

It's the final day of your memory making trip to the Viking Trail! It's time to take in our scenic drive south one last time on route to Deer Lake Airport or Port aux Basques Ferry Terminal. Depending on departure times, you may have time for stops you have missed on your way back down the coast and some last-minute snaps at scenic pull offs along the way! Overnight in Gros Morne - Deer Lake region and reminisce in the amazing memories you'll want to share about the Viking Trail when you get home!
